Reports on legivater reutrality matters are taken to the Water Neutrality Executive Board for their consideration and recommendations. This consists of senior representatives of the signatories to this statement, as well as representatives from DERA¹, DILH² and Of wat. The Executive Board is supported by a Water Neutrality Lead Officer Group who in turnate supported by smaller and more focused working groups. All of these are coordinated by the Water Neutrality Project Manager which is a joint post between Husham District Gunoil, Gawley Brough Gunoil, Oridester District Gunoil, West Sussex Gunty Gunoil and the South Downs National Park Authority.
